Agreements

On September 26, 2018, North American Electric Reliability Corporation (NERC), ReliabilityFirst Corporation (RF), and Midwest Reliability Organization (MRO) submitted a joint petition requesting (1) to transfer the registration of Wisconsin Public Service Corporation and Upper Michigan Energy Resources Corporation from the MRO Regional Entity footprint to the RF Regional Entity footprint, and (2) to revise Exhibit A to the Regional Delegation Agreement (RDA) between NERC and MRO and Exhibit A of the RDA between NERC and RF to reflect the proposed transfer.

Notice of this filing was issued on September 27, 2018, with protests and interventions due on or before October 16, 2018. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure. 18 C.F.R. § 385.214. No adverse comments were received.

NERC's uncontested filing is accepted pursuant to the relevant authority delegated to the Director, Office of Energy Market Regulation, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, effective January 1, 2019, as requested.

This action shall not be construed as approving any other application, including proposed revisions of Electric Reliability Organization or Regional Entity rules or procedures pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 375.307(a)(2)(vi). This action does not constitute

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approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed documents. Such action shall not be deemed as recognition of any claimed right or obligation associated therewith and such action is without prejudice to any findings or orders that have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against the Electric Reliability Organization or any Regional Entity.

This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
