On April 1, 2008, the North American Electric Reliability Corporation (NERC) filed revised Violation Risk Factors for Facilities Design, Connections, and Maintenance Reliability Standards approved in Order No. 705.<sup>1</sup> This filing was submitted to comply with Paragraph 135 of Order No. 705 directing NERC to revise 10 Violation Risk Factor assignments identified in Appendix A of that order.

Notice of this filing was issued on April 11, 2008 with comments, protests or motions to intervene due on or before April 22, 2008.

Notices of intervention and unopposed timely motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rule of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214 (2007)). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214. No protests or adverse comments were filed.
