**RE: Errata to Petition of the North American Electric Reliability Corporation for Approval of Six NERC Glossary Definitions and Request for Shortened Response Period and Expedited Action
Docket No. RD16-7-000**

Dear Secretary Bose:

The North American Electric Reliability Corporation (“NERC”)¹ hereby submits errata to its petition filed on June 2, 2016 in Docket No. RD16-7-000.² NERC submits this errata filing to correct an inadvertent formatting error in the Petition that has come to NERC’s attention since original submission to the Commission.

In its Petition, NERC requests Commission approval of six NERC Glossary definitions, including the term “Scheduled Net Interchange (NIs).” In certain instances in the Petition, the acronym for “Scheduled Net Interchange,” or “NIs,” includes a minor font inconsistency. Specifically, NERC references the term “Scheduled Net Interchange” using the acronym “NIS” rather than “NIs.”³ Because the Implementation Plan and related definitions use the acronym “NIs,” NERC submits this errata to correct the record.
