## Basis for Intervening:

NERC was formed to serve as the electric reliability organization (âœEROâ?) authorized by Section 215 of the Federal Power Act (âœFPAâ?). NERC was certified as the ERO by the Commissionâ™s Order issued July 20, 2006, in Docket No. RR06-1-000. NERCâ™s mission is to improve the reliability and security of the bulk power system in North America. To achieve that, NERC develops and enforces reliability standards; monitors the bulk power system; assesses future adequacy; audits owners, operators and users for preparedness; and educates and trains industry personnel. NERC is a self-regulatory organization that relies on the diverse and collective expertise of industry participants. As the ERO, NERC is subject to oversight by the Commission and applicable governmental authorities in Canada.

Because the New York Independent System Operator, Inc.â™s (NYISO) Report on Broader Regional Markets; Long-Term Solutions to Lake Erie Loop Flow, filed with the Commission on January 12, 2010, includes proposed regional market solutions predicated on NERC actions, NERC has a substantial and direct interest in this proceeding.
