Dear Ms. Bose:

On July 30, 2008, the North American Electric Reliability Corporation ("NERC") submitted a petition in accordance with Section 215(d)(1) of the Federal Power Act ("FPA") and Part 39.5 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's (the "Commission") regulations seeking approval of the proposed Reliability Standard of NERC, PRC-023-1 — Transmission Relay Loadability.

It has come to NERC's attention that there was one inadvertent reference to the requested effective date. By this filing, NERC corrects the reference on page 27 under item 12 of the body of the filing to conform it to the introductory and conclusion paragraphs, as well as the text of the Reliability Standard. Specifically, the reference to "effective the first day of the quarter no sooner than fifteen months after regulatory approval by the Commission" should instead state that the Reliability Standard be made "effective consistent with the implementation plan accompanying the Reliability Standard."

Accordingly, NERC respectfully requests that the Commission accept this errata filing and issue an order consistent with the comments provided herein.
