**UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR A BRIEF TEN DAY EXTENSION OF TIME
OF THE
NORTH AMERICAN ELECTRIC RELIABILITY CORPORATION**

Pursuant to Rules 212 and 2008 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's ("FERC" or the "Commission") Rules of Practice and Procedure, 18 C.F.R. §§ 385.212 and 385.2008 (2007), the North American Electric Reliability Corporation ("NERC") hereby submits an Unopposed Motion for a Brief Ten Day Extension of Time from July 15 to July 25, 2008 to allow it to submit a compliance filing in response to the Commission's May 16, 2008 Order in the above-captioned proceeding.¹ The Commission's Order upheld the registration of New Harquahala Generating Company, LLC ("Harquahala") on the NERC Compliance Registry within the Western Electricity Coordinating Council ("WECC") for the functions of transmission owner ("TO") and transmission operator ("TOP"). In addition, the Commission directed NERC to submit a compliance filing identifying the Reliability Standards and Requirements that will be applicable to Harquahala. NERC's compliance filing is due on July 15, 2008.

NERC, WECC and Harquahala met in person on June 18, 2008 and July 2, 2008 and held a telephone conference call on July 10, 2008 to discuss the applicable Reliability Standards and Requirements in accordance with the May 16 Order. Despite the diligent efforts to date, the parties are continuing to work on a few remaining issues, but additional time is required to allow

the parties to fully address them. Accordingly, NERC respectfully requests a brief additional ten day period of time to and including July 25, 2008 for the filing of the compliance filing.

Harquahala and WECC have authorized NERC to state that they support NERC's request for an extension of time.

WHEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, NERC respectfully requests that the Commission grant an extension of time of ten days to and including July 25, 2008, for the submittal of a compliance filing in response to the Commission's May 16 Order.
