NOTICE OF EXTENSION OF TIME

(April 17, 2008)

On April 16, 2008, the North American Electric Reliability Corporation (NERC) filed a motion for an extension of time to issue a revised registry demonstration for the Southeastern Power Administration (SEPA) as required by the Commission's Order Remanding Proceeding to Electric Reliability Organization issued February 21, 2008, in the above-referenced proceeding. *Southeastern Power Administration*, 122 FERC ¶ 61,140 (2008) (February 21 Order). The motion states that while NERC and SEPA's applicable regional entity, SERC Reliability Corporation (SERC), have been undertaking diligent efforts to comply with the February 21 Order, additional time is needed to obtain information to further develop the record and to complete the analyses that are needed for a new registry determination. The motion further states that the SEPA and SEPA customers support the request for additional time.

Upon consideration, notice is hereby given that an extension of time for NERC to comply with the Commission's February 21 Order is granted to and including June 20, 2008, as requested by NERC.
